With the theme, **“Synergy Unleashed: Becoming Smart Cities Through Strategic Partnerships”**, this activity aims to serve as a platform to bring local chief executives, government leaders, industries, and business players together for knowledge-sharing, networking, and capacity-building that emphasizes the importance of partnerships for the creation of smarter and sustainable communities in the country. As ISCENE 2024 coincides with the city’s annual Gawagaway-yan Festival that will be staged from April 1 to 14, 2024, participants shall also be given an opportunity to join the scheduled festival events and activities that will truly give them an amazing and memorable experience in Cauayan City.

Relative thereto, all Provincial Governors, City and Municipal Mayors are hereby encouraged to participate in the event together with officials and employees from local governments.

The officials may participate in official business, provided that the training is within the Capability Development Agenda of the LGU, and provided further that any expense of a participant shall not be charged against the 20% Development Fund or from whatever source which may prejudice poverty reduction efforts. The payment of corresponding traveling expenses, registration fee per participant to cover accommodation, meals and training materials, and other incidental expenses, may be authorized, and chargeable to local funds, subject to the availability thereof and the usual accounting and auditing rules.

All Regional Directors are hereby directed to cause the widest dissemination of this Memorandum Circular to LGUs within their respective areas of jurisdiction.
